Floyd. I just wanted to drop you a short note to let you know how pleased I was with the results obtained using the DeFoul Anti Foul Paint remover. I first learned of the product at the Vancouver Boat Show. As with any new product I had some scepticism with the claims that it could be sprayed on and pressure washed off and I would be down to the gel or barrier coat. I have an 11 year old, 38 foot catamaran, with a minimum 10 coats of antifouling paint on it. I was looking at least 4 days of scrapping and sanding so you can understand my scepticism that a product could be sprayed on, left overnight, and washed off the next morning.

Protocol stood by their claims and the hull was taken from many thick layers of antifouling paint to the barrier coat in the Marina wash pit. I can say without a doubt that this process saved time, money and a lot of sore muscles.
